Rules of Enrollment

We want everyone who attends camp to have a super fun time and create wonderful memories! For this reason, we would greatly appreciate if you communicate to your camper prior to attending camp about bringing a great attitude, a sense of adventure, curiosity, and respect for others and all living things—to camp. Included in this respect for others is our strict policy of arriving and departing on time for camp as explained in these Rules of Enrollment. Thank you for respecting The Urban Chickens and all campers in attendance by being on time!

GENERAL:

1. No candy or gum, food or beverages may be consumed during interaction time with chickens and ducks.
2. Please leave all jewelry at home.
3. If camper is on medication, or a reduced exercise program from camper's doctor that is new or different from information provided on the Camp Registration Agreement, or authorized persons for pick up or emergency contacts have changed, please inform adult camp staff at camp check in each morning.
4. For those with pet allergies, we will be around chickens during the camp session and also have a very friendly farm cat that is often with us. We will also be learning about honeybees.
5. After Camp, please change into fresh clothes to enjoy the remainder of your day!

FOOD/BEVERAGES: The Urban Chickens' camp does not provide any food other than the items below:

- ice water or ice water with lemon or cucumber
- garden veggies fresh from our organic garden
- watermelon
- otter pops

All snack food and drink items are otherwise supplied by the camper. Please be sure to provide any allergy information in the health information section of the Camp Registration Agreement and supply your camper with their own food and drinks if they are unable to consume the above items. Thank you.

THE URBAN CHICKENS SUMMER CAMP LOCATION: The Urban Chickens' backyard farm is located above Safeway on Finn Hill in Kirkland. After you have registered and paid for camp you will receive a confirmation email with additional camp information and specific directions to camp. For privacy purposes and for the safety of our own children, we do not publicly provide our location address on the internet and ask that you please keep it private as well. Thank you!!

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ATTENDANCE: Camp is from 8am-12pm (Noon) Monday through Friday. Campers are expected to arrive at camp between 8:00-8:05am as camp begins promptly at 8:10am. Please be respectful of all campers and be on time.

Parents are expected to pick up their children for departure from camp promptly at 12:00pm (Noon). There is no aftercare available.

Please be on time and be aware there is a 5-minute leeway to pick up your child late and after that time you will be charged a \$10 late fee which must be paid in full before your child is allowed to attend camp the next day.

Further, if your child is not picked up within 15 minutes after a camp sessions ends, your child forfeits the opportunity to continue attending camp for the rest of the week and there are absolutely no refunds. **We are unable to provide aftercare.**

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: Campers must wait together as a group until all campers for the session have arrived. Junior camp staff will provide interaction/an activity while campers wait. Campers are to remain under staff supervision at all times and are not allowed to explore the facilities on their own. Please ensure your child understands this.

***You must sign out your child with camp staff prior to leaving with your child.**

VISITING CAMP/OBSERVATION: Parents are invited to visit camp on the last day of camp during our end of camp show and “bring your own picnic”/“snack time”.

LOST & FOUND: All items left at camp are placed in the lost and found. Items left, lost or stolen are not the responsibility of The Urban Chickens. Lost and Found items are donated the 15th of each month.

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME: To enjoy our time at camp, the following items are to be left at home:

- cell phones
- electronics of any kind
- money
- valuables/jewelry/watches that could be lost or stolen
- weapons of any kind
- candy
- pets

If a camper does bring any of the above items to camp, the item(s) will be safely stored until the end of camp, when it can be picked up, or parent(s) will be contacted to pick up and remove the item(s) from camp.

DISCIPLINE: In minor situations, camp staff will explore camper motives when a child acts out and appropriate consequences will be explained to the camper and carried out, such as a verbal redirection or time out from an activity.

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If a situation persists or is more serious, camp staff will contact parent(s) via a phone call and parents will talk with their own child. Appropriate consequences will be explained to the camper and then carried out after discussion with parent(s). In severe situations, a child may need to be sent home. No refunds are given when a camper misses camp or needs to be sent home.

There is absolutely no form of physical punishment.

PAYMENT POLICY: No refunds or credits.
